Vision

Learn, grow and play together.

Principles

The purpose of this funding is to ensure improvement in the quality of sport and PE provision for all children. (Department for Education, March 2013)

- We will ensure that sport and PE provision addresses the needs of all our pupils, including those who belong to disadvantaged, vulnerable and gifted groups.
- Primary School Sports funding will be allocated following a whole school needs analysis which will identify priority classes, groups and individuals. In order to address any (identified) areas of need, this funding may be used across particular classes, key stages or whole school at any time during the 2017/18 academic year. (Subsequent years are subject to changes in funding.)

Provision

The range of provision the school may consider making could include:

- Group work with an experienced sports teacher, focussed on overcoming gaps in learning
- Increased pupil participation in sports
- Additional teaching and learning opportunities provided through Professional development courses
- Cover release for professional development
- Quality assured CPD modules/materials
- Curriculum PE Team Teaching opportunities
- Qualified Sports coaching (Curriculum / After-School)
- Change 4 Life sports clubs
- Sports competitions (Inter / Intra)
- Holiday sports clubs
- Leadership development for KS2 children
- Termly PE coordinator workshops
- The implementation of a 'Base Line Measurement' to measure impact and progress levels of physical activity across the whole school
- Continue to develop the opportunities made available for our children to enjoy one hour of physical activity every day.

All our work will be aimed at increasing attainment, participation, improving confidence and skills and encouraging a life-long love of sport together with an understanding of the health benefits participation in sports activities offers.

Reporting

It will be the responsibility of the Headteacher, in conjunction with the Deputy Head Teacher / PE coordinator, to produce regular reports for the Full Governing Body on:

- progress made towards improvements, by year group;
- an outline of the provision that was made since the last meeting; and
- an evaluation of the cost effectiveness, in terms of the progress made by the pupils receiving a particular provision, when compared with other forms of support.

The Governors of the school will ensure that there is an annual statement published on the school website on how the Primary Sport Premium Funding has been used to improve the uptake and outcomes for PE/sports both within and beyond the school day. This task will be carried out within the requirements published by the Department for Education.

Appeal

Any appeals against this policy will be through the school's complaints procedure.
