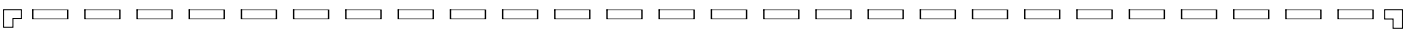

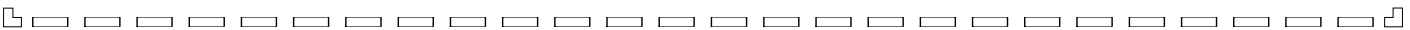
There are leaflets available from the school office, which we will send home to anyone who has made an enquiry for a younger sibling. If you know of anyone—please let us know! Thank you.

Junior Children: Free School Meals: for all children moving to the juniors (from Year 2 to Year 3), please note that their meals will need to be paid for—£2.20 per child per day (please make cheques payable to *Aspens Services*). If you think your child might be eligible for Free School Meals, please check on the Cornwall Council website or ask at the school office. *Even if your child does not have school meals, the school receives funding for the children, so it is vital that all parents check their eligibility.* Thank you.
