There are leaflets available from the school office, which we will send home to anyone who has made an enquiry for a younger sibling. If you know of anyone—please let us know! Thank you.



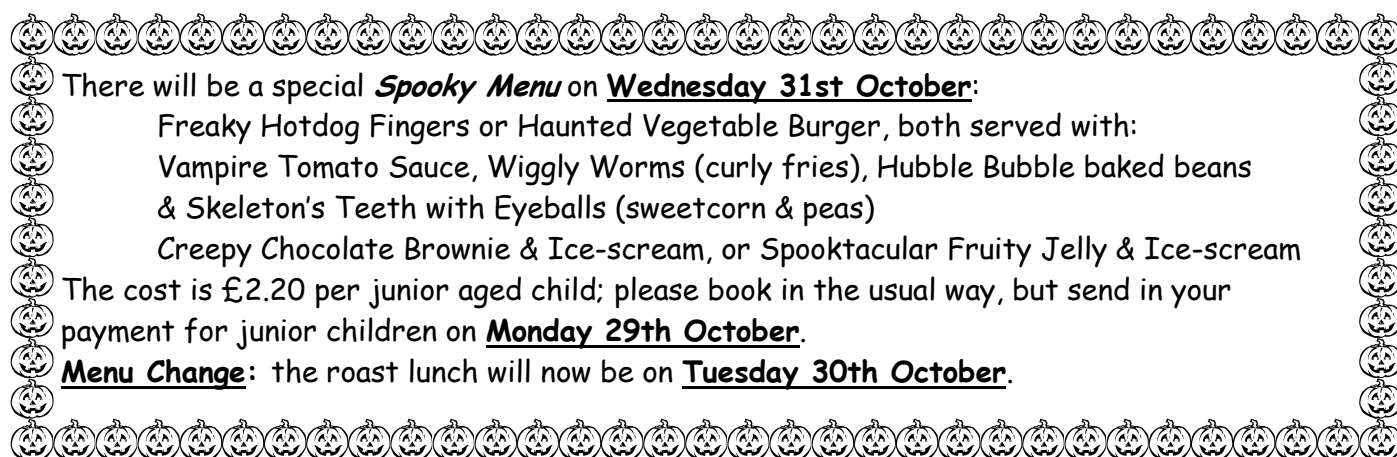
