Swimming—for children in Years 3, 4, 5 & 6: Swimming started on *Monday 10th September*, and there will be ten sessions in total (excluding INSET and half term week).
We are requesting a voluntary contribution of £2 per child per week for transport to the leisure centre, and would be very grateful if you could send this into school please. If you are able to pay £20 in one go, that would be very helpful, or you can pay £2 per week. We have also set up the payment on School Money for you to pay online.
All children remembered their swimming kit this week—thank you very much! Please continue to send in your child with their swimming costume and towel in a bag, with an spare small towel for those with long hair, and goggles if used—*please name all items!* Thank you.
