

PE & Sport Funding for Stuart Road Primary School 2015/2016

In the academic year 2015-2016, Stuart Road Primary School has received £8882.

The money received is being used to pay for the following:

- Annual subscription to the Plymouth Schools Sports Partnership (PSSP)- which has allowed access to participation in local competitive events city-wide but primarily within the Stoke Damerel Academic Council such as Y1/2 and Y3/4 Mixed Football, Brickfields Athletics Tournament, Multiskills Festivals for KS1, Bikeability and Swimming sessions at Plymouth Life Centre for Y5/6.
- Specialist sports coaching for high quality PE sessions, whilst also providing PE CPD for teaching staff.
- Transportation & supply costs for participation of inter-school sporting events.
- Replacement balls to replenish stocks within PE equipment.
- PE equipment to support positive play at Break times e.g., new goal post, dodgeballs, skipping ropes.
- Cost of running additional after school club (martial arts) paying for a qualified instructor to provide additional sporting opportunity for the children.
- Cost of table tennis tables, table tennis bats, nets and balls for after school table tennis club.
- Cost of transport for Trust Schools Sports Day with Weston Mill Community Primary & Stoke Damerel Primary Schools.
