Curriculum...

- **English** : Following Literacy and Language scheme of work
 - Gives every child a deep understanding of what they read using the special 'three reads' approach
 - Fully prepares every child for writing using a planning, drafting and revising method
 - Teaches grammar in context so that children can apply it seamlessly in their own writing
 - Supports the grammar and punctuation aspects of the Key Stage 2 tests
- **Mathematics:** Following the new National Curriculum
 - Teaching for mastery which uses the Singapore style.
 - Calculations policy will be coming home soon...
