Many more ways and opportunities to earn Green Dojos than to earn Red Dojos.


# What we expect from our pupils

# Encompass



System to protect most vulnerable children.

Based on the knowledge that statistically 1 in 5 children will experience some form of domestic abuse.

(Not just violence) can be emotional, financial psychological amongst others.

Police will ring before 9am following an incident.

Myself, Amy or Celia will inform the class teacher so we can be aware and meet the child's needs.

Parents need to keep an open dialogue with the school.

Children need to be in school – safe place.



# Name of the school



School name is out dated and doesn't reflect its current role in the family of schools.

Could become Charlestown ACE Academy or something similar.

Uniform changes will be phased in, although Governors are exploring a free welcome gift for all pupils.

Consultation will be via letter and survey monkey starting Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> October, with the new name in place from September 2018.

We will be in touch once the consultation is complete.




# Behaviour, welfare and attendance
