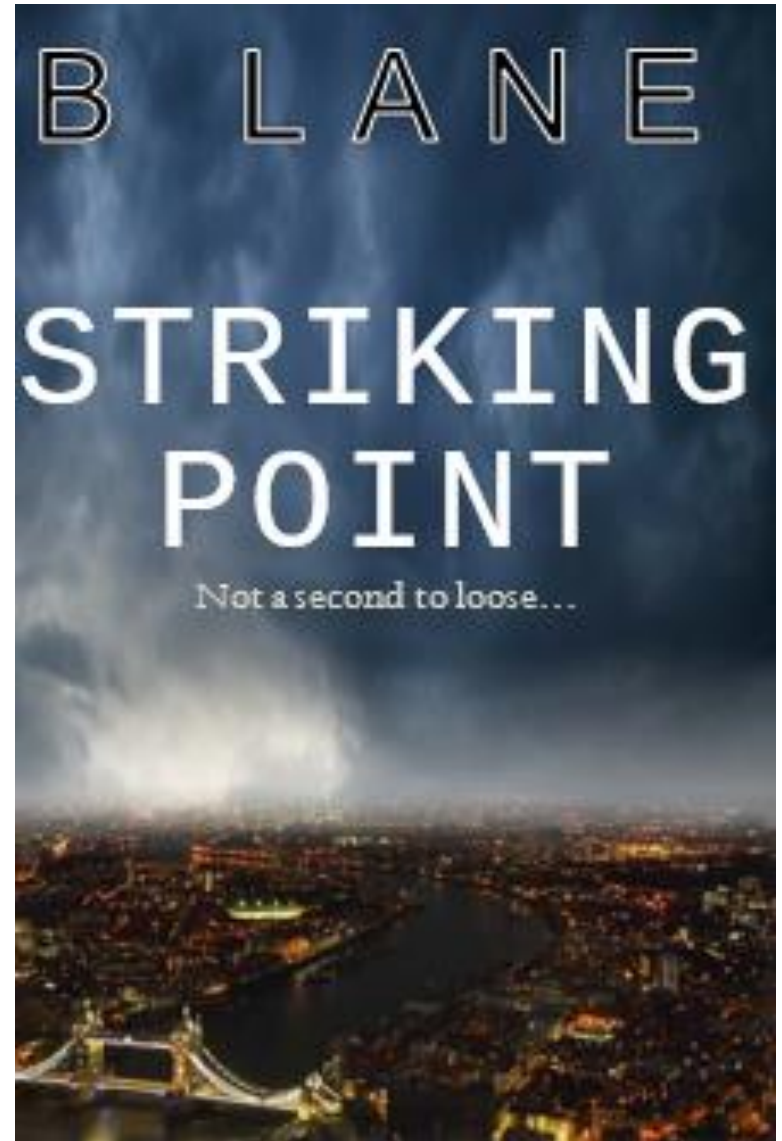
# I moonlight as a writer.
