

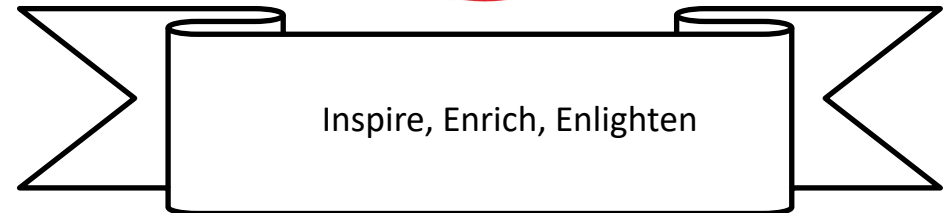
Agreement for Pupils

To help your child to do well at school, all staff will do their best to:

- Ensure your child's physical and social wellbeing at all times
- Foster feelings of confidence, self-worth and belonging
- Ensure the acceptance of all people regardless of their race, culture and beliefs, gender or sexual orientation
- Deliver a broad, balanced and carefully planned curriculum which meets the needs of each child that is interesting and exciting, including learning outside, listening to children about their thoughts on school
- Expect the best from your child in behaviour and work
- Inform children, parents and carers what the teachers aim to teach each term in advance
- Actively welcome parents and carers into the life of the school
- Ensure that teaching staff are always available (by mutual agreement) to discuss any concerns you might have about your child's progress or general welfare
- Contact parents and carers as soon as possible if we are concerned about your child's work or behaviour
- Contact parents and carers if there is a problem concerning your child's attendance and/or punctuality
- Regularly set and monitor home tasks which reflect your child's learning
- Provide regular opportunities to meet with teachers to discuss progress and targets
- Keep parents and carers informed about general school matters through newsletters, the school website and notice board
- Maintain confidentiality at all times
- Ensure your child follows the Acceptable Use policy when using IT

Agreement for Parent/carer

To help my child to do well at school, I will do my best to:

- Ensure my child attends school regularly and on time
- Ensure my child comes to school properly equipped with a reading book, PE kit and is correctly dressed in school uniform (with names in *all* clothing)
- Contact the school as soon as possible if my child is absent
- Update the office of any changes to contact details (including new phone numbers and any change of address)
- Make sure that my child is collected on time or notify the school if there is a problem (including clarifying who will collect my child if I am unable to do it)
- Make the school aware of any concerns, problems or medical conditions which may affect my child's work or behaviour
- Support the school's policy on behaviour (available from the school office and the website as well as given to all new parents) to ensure my child behaves well

- Support my child with their homework and reading, and wherever possible, promote opportunities for learning at home
- Attend parents and carers evenings and discussions about my child's progress
- Ensure that my child follows the Acceptable Use policy when using IT
