Behaviour, welfare and attendance

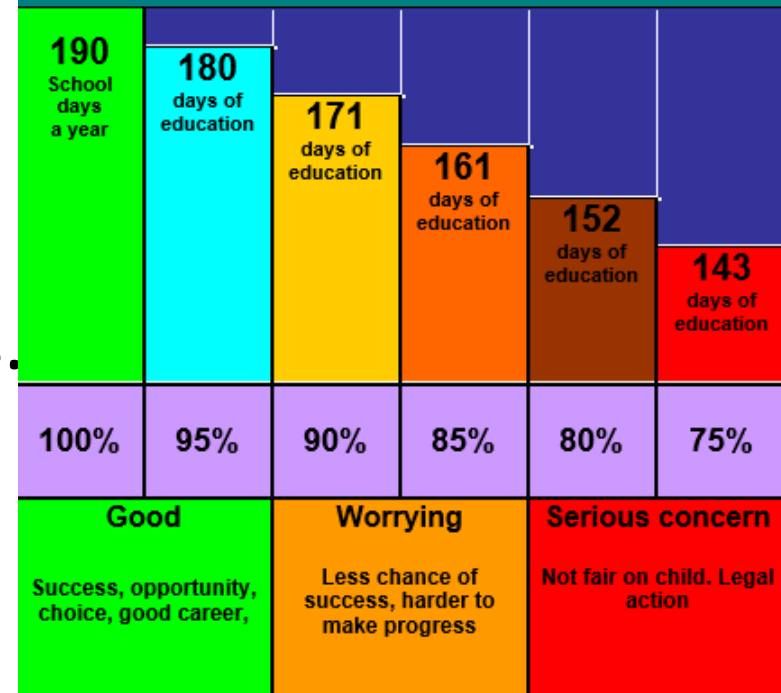


EVERY SCHOOL DAY COUNTS

Budget



Costs have risen between 7 and 12%. Our budget has not increased. Cornish schools continue to receive less per child than many other LAs. The LA is no longer funding expansion project. We have refused additional children in those years in which our admission number isn't 60.

We are only funded for the number of children on roll.

May need to review the class structure in future years.

Children (and staff) are being reminded to be careful with resources.
