

Kahoot! in the Maths Department

We have started to use a great new resource in the maths department. Kahoot! is a free resource that you can download and then run various quizzes on the smart board at the front of the class. Pupils can then interact through ipads giving their answers from a multiple choice selection. Our pupils love to use the ipads and this gives us the perfect opportunity to assess their learning and have some fun at the same time!

Kahoot! can be run on individual ipads or as a class group. There are hundreds of quizzes to choose from but also the opportunity to write your own. The most recent use of Kahoot! was for pupil conferencing. Pupils were asked to answer questions on their maths learning enabling us to look at favoured resources and how their resilience is developing. It's good to know that the majority of our pupils like maths and feel confident in their learning. It will be interesting to revisit our pupil conferencing in the summer term and see if their thoughts have changed!
