

English Tasks

Day 1 - 22/10 – complete the reading comprehension on either World Environment Day or Air Pollution

Day 2 – 23/10 – create a poster to tell people how to stop air pollution. Think of a catchy slogan and try to write the information under different subheadings. Can you include any complex sentences using WHEN, AS & BECAUSE in your writing?

Remember that a complex sentence is a simple sentence with a subordinate clause added to it.

Eg Air pollution is bad. (simple sentence)

Because it damages your lungs, air pollution is bad. (complex sentence)

Driving cars causes pollution. (simple sentence)

When cars use petrol, driving causes air pollution. (complex sentence)

Finally add some pictures to illustrate your poster.

Day 3 – 2/11 – Complete the refugee reading comprehension. This will help you learn more about what a difficult time Ahmet and his family must have been through (The Boy at the Back of the Class).

Days 4 & 5 – 3/11- 4/11 - You are going to create an information booklet for refugees about our wonderful school and surrounding area. To begin with, jot down ideas on the 'Writing Planner'. If you want, change some of the subheadings or add your own.

If I were doing this task, I'd create a section called 'What Can You Do On The Seafront?' I'd then write about a range of things I know. Again, try to include some complex sentences in your writing.

Eg Along the seafront, you can find the greatest pier in the country. Brighton Pier is free to visit. When the weather is nice, you can sit for hours on free deckchairs to enjoy the views. Because there are so many food sidestalls, you will never go hungry. It is the perfect spot to eat a packed lunch, as there are public toilets (just before the indoor amusement arcade).
