



Dear Parents and Carers,

### Spring Term Clubs

Clubs will begin running in the Spring Term and this letter hopefully contains all the information you should need.

Please see the attached Clubs Information sheet which tells you all about the clubs that are available over the Spring Term. Please look carefully at the dates, time of each club and note these in your diary as soon as you have booked your club. Not all clubs run every week due to staff training, room availability and other school events. If your child is here for a club that doesn't run, they will go to Starfish After School Club, which you will be charged for.

Clubs must be booked and paid for through ParentPay and will be made available **from Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> January**. Payment has to be made in full at the time of booking and cannot be made through the school office – ParentPay only please. If your child attended Textiles club this term, the club will be available for them **ONLY** to book up until **7<sup>th</sup> January** – after that, any remaining places will be opened up to other children in Red Pandas and Penguins.

You will only be able to book and pay for a club if spaces are available so once you have paid, you are guaranteed a space! Please do not ask staff to consider an additional child for the club – numbers are decided for a range of reasons, including child safety.

The clubs vary in price. Some clubs are run by outside providers who decide their own costs. Teachers run clubs as part of their role in school. Support staff, such as Teaching Assistants, are paid extra to run clubs and this is included in the costs. The cost of clubs also covers any equipment and resources that are required. Any profit made from clubs will be added to school fund and used for school resources. If your child would be interested in attending a club that is run by school staff but there are financial reasons that prevent them attending, please contact me via the school office by Friday 10<sup>th</sup> January.

If you have any Lego that you no longer use and would like to donate to Lego club, it would be VERY gratefully received – the more Lego we have, the more children we can have at Lego club!
