Dear Parents,

Thank you for your support in getting the children settled back into school this year. They have made a great start and I have thoroughly enjoyed working with them over the past week.

There are just a few things that I would like to let you know about the coming weeks:

PE Days

PE lessons are currently on Friday. Children can come to school in their PE kit on a Friday and remain in it throughout the day. If children have pierced ears they need to either bring in some tape to cover them with or, ideally, take the earrings out for PE. We will try to get outside for PE as much as possible so it is worth them having a hoody/jacket as the weather becomes cooler.

Homework

Maths homework is currently Doodle Maths (as explained on a previous email). Each child has also been given a spelling booklet to bring home which shows what they will be practising in class each week this year. This copy is for them to keep at home in order to practise the spellings further. As we get into our Guided Reading groups, a small amount of reading (5-10 minutes) will be given each evening. It is important that this reading is done as there will often be tasks the following day based on what has been read.
