Just to let you know about a few changes that are happening. As you know we started taking 2 year old children in September. After the first term we have realised that the current room they are in is not ideal. It is too big and it is not easy for Reception to then have to use a different room in the afternoons. As a result of this we are making some changes during the Christmas holidays. We are having toilet facilities fitted in to Miss Fawcett's current classroom and this will then become Turtle Tot's (2 year olds) room in the New Year. Year 1 and 2 will then have a new classroom on the other corridor (old cooking room which is now a spare classroom).
