Cycling Day—Friday 7th July

Cambois to Paris cycling day was a great success on Friday and I am overwhelmed by the efforts children and parents went to raise money! Some individual children raised over £75

I would like to share with you a few recent successes that we have had;

In June 83% of pupils passed the phonics skills test which was 12% in 2015 and 62% in 2016. This is an amazing result and takes us in line with National Averages.

75% of pupils achieved the expected standard for Maths and Writing and 87.5% for reading at the end of Key stage 2. The combined score is 79% which is well above the national average of 61% and an amazing achievement. Last year this was 28% for reading, 56% for writing and 28% for Maths. This shows the progress we have made and the outstanding teachers we have.

Our attendance is 97.2% and this is way above the national average and a true reflection that children enjoy coming to school.

Behaviour around school is excellent and this shows through the amount of children achieving the 'green' standard.

We have had 17 new children join the school since last September and most of these have been a result of word of mouth from the county and from other parents particularly, about how effectively we support pupils with special educational needs or additional needs.
