



Courageous Castles - Homework Tasks



Geography:

Research a local castle, e.g. Tutbury Castle. What can you find out about it? Perhaps you could visit a castle and gather information and photographs to share with your friends at school.

History:

Find out about a historic event or individual relating to Castles/Battles, e.g. The Battle of Hastings or Henry V111. Write a diary entry from the point of view of somebody who would have lived at the time of your chosen event, or from the point of view of your chosen individual. What would life have been like?

English:

Research your family's coat of arms. Create a fact file using information you find about your coat of arms.

Design & Technology:

Design a healthy menu for a King or Queen's banquet. What food would they eat at these events? Can you create an appealing menu using pictures and adjectives to describe your food?

Maths:

Create a timetable for a member of our royal family. What events will take place during their day and at what times? Make a list of their important duties and use clock faces to show the times they are expected to meet people or be in a new place.

Science:

Design a castle, taking into consideration the materials you would use to build it. Which materials would be the most suitable? Which materials would not be suitable? How will you protect your castle when it is under attack? What features will your castle have to enable you to fight back?
