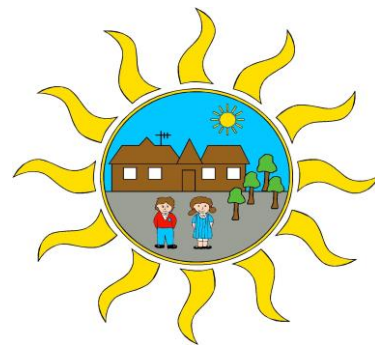

Christmas Fair
