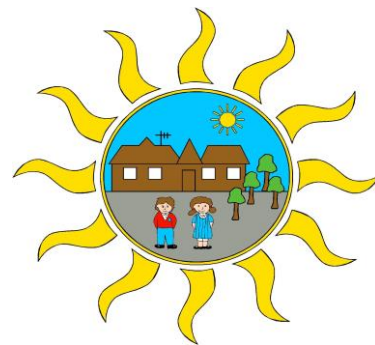

Happy New Year. I hope you all had a restful break and the children are ready to return with their positive attitudes and an 'I can do it' mindset. We saw huge progress in the children in the first term, let's keep it up. Thank you also for all your ongoing support with helping to learn spelling rules and hearing your children read.

Maths and English lessons

In English, we shall be covering poetry, recounts and traditional tales from other cultures.

In Maths we shall be covering number – multiplication and division, statistics, measurement – money, weight, height and length.

The children will continue to learn their times tables and number bond facts, alongside regular reading, phonics and spelling opportunities. Help at home with all these activities is always important to children's progress.

Topic

This term the class topic will look at Water. We will look at the seven continents and five oceans of the world. The children will use basic geographical knowledge vocabulary to refer to key physical features including sea, ocean and weather. They will use maps, atlases and globes to identify the United Kingdom and its countries.

The children will enter the world of famous naturalist Charles Darwin and his discoveries. They will research the Galapagos Islands and create a fact-file.
