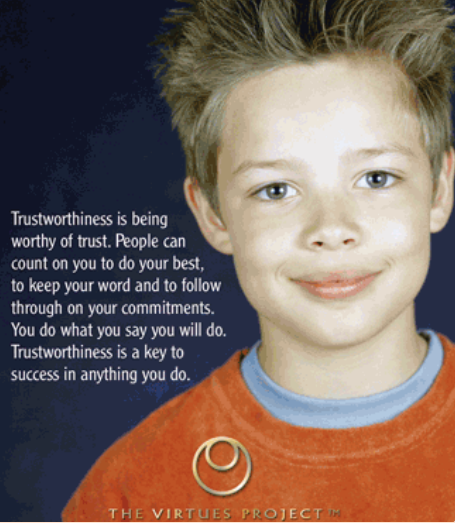

Virtues

This week's virtue is 'Trustworthiness'

Foundation stage

Last week we focused on rhyming words and linking this to our story A Singing Mermaid. The Reception and Nursery children thought of words that rhyme with our names and the seaside, for example "it is fab to see a crab". Phonics last week were the phonemes 'igh', 'oa', and 'oo'.

In maths we have been adding two single digit numbers and recording this in numbers and pictures.

During our forest schools session, some children made willow star wands, looked for animal tracks and made some of their own, played games and used sticks to make different sounds.

Key Stage 1 Well done all KS1 for filling their jars. The children are all looking forward to their games afternoon on Monday.

To help us with our writing of a senses poem, the children tasted a variety of fruit. They were delicious. In Year 2 maths the children have been learning about temperature. Please help them to read weather reports this week. Year 1 are problem solving using real life experiences. Get them to add and subtract things around the home. We will be reviewing their 'Staying Healthy Topic' this week. Ask them what their favourite part has been to help them for Thursday's lesson.

Key Stage 2 For children in KS2 there is a fantastic opportunity to work with architect Richard Reid, in an environmental education, community art project. The free event will take place over the weekend of 2nd and 3rd March and involve learning about how Porthleven has changed architecturally over time through creating a townscape mural of Porthleven. Children will learn about the processes that architects take from initial sketches to final design and also receive practical tuition in improving their own drawing skills. Over the weekend children will be given the opportunity to work with a variety of different media and showcase their work to parents and friends. Both the Saturday and Sunday will run from 9.45—3.30 and all we ask is for the children to bring a packed-lunch as everything else will be provided. The event has spaces for twenty children and will be offered on a first come, first served basis.
