

Literary snowballs

Instructions:

1. Form two teams and go to opposite sides of the room.
2. Give each team member a piece of white paper (their snowball) and make sure the members of the team all have the same colored pens.
3. Write down a question based on a book the class is familiar with (consider one you're studying), crumple it into a snowball and toss it at the other team.
4. To get rid of the snowball on your side of the room, you must answer the question.
5. If you receive a snowball with an answer to your question, make sure the answer provided is correct. If it is not, throw it back! If it is, write a new question to get rid of it again.
6. When the music ends, the team with the least snowballs wins!
