As part of our Tudors topic in Spring 1, I have booked for us to attend the matinee performance of the Horrible Histories show 'Terrible Tudors'. Whilst we are over in Southampton, I wanted to make the most of the day and have also booked us in for a guided tour of the Tudor House in Southampton. Here is the information that they have given about the show: 'from the horrible Henries to the end of evil Elizabeth, hear the legend (and the lies!) about the torturing Tudors. Find out the fate of Henry's headless wives and his punch up with the Pope. Meet Bloody Mary and see Ed fall dead in his bed. Survive the Spanish Armada as it sails into the audience!'

The expected timings of the day are as follows (but are subject to change):

7.45am	Children meet at school to leave at 8.00 am
8.45am	We are booked onto the Redjet (what an exciting adventure!)
10.00am	Arrive at the theatre to find our seats. The show starts at 10.30am. There will be an interval half way through the show with a total running time of 2 hours.
12.30pm	Arrive at Tudor House. Have our lunches in their lunch room then our guided tour.
3.45pm	Return ferry home to be collected in Cowes by coach.
4.45pm	Arrive back at school for home time exhausted but hopefully very happy!



We are able to provide this trip at the cost of £18.00 per child which will need to be paid by 15<sup>th</sup> March 2019 via ParentPay. As it is linked to our curriculum, we would very much like for all of the class to be able to join us so please speak to us if you have any questions or concerns. We are aware that many Year 3 parents are currently paying for the Chichester trip so don't worry if you need to pay for this closer to the time we just wanted to give as much notice as possible!
