

Year 6 - Autumn Term 2 2018 - Theme: World War 1!



English - War Horse

This half term our literacy we will be using our focus of World War 1 to develop our English skills.


Starting off with the theme of 'Remembrance', the children will be developing their poetry skills and creating their own wartime poems developing their use of emotive language.

Using an amazing, emotions short film called 'The piano' which based around the life of a soldier, the children will then write stories with flashback developing their use of juxtaposition, implied emotion and using repetition for effect.

Our book study will be focussed on 'War Horse' by Michael Morpurgo. The children will have the opportunity to discuss historical accuracy within a narrative text and also how an author has used as alternative perspectives to deliver a story.


Maths

The children have made a great start to their maths learning this half term! Within the term we will be continuing to develop the children's arithmetic learning with a focus on fractions. The units of work will involve adding and subtracting fractions with different denominators as well as learning how to multiply and divide them.



Homework

We have been really impressed with the children's commitment to completing their homework in their new books and been wowed by some additional homework being completed at home! Please remember we are here to support and help with homework - there is a Year 6 lunchtime homework club and a whole school after school club Thursday; please contact the office or speak to your child's class teacher for any further information.



Theme

In line with the upcoming centenary celebrations on November 11th, this half term our theme will take a historical focus and the children will be studying some key events and facts of the First World War. They will study the tough conditions



of surviving on the front line and the day to day tribulations of life during wartime Britain as well as looking into how war helped to develop technology and effect how we live today.



P.E

Outdoor P.E sessions remain on a Thursday afternoon this half term and as the days get colder, please ensure that your child has weather appropriate clothing. Year 6's will also have



skateboarding sessions on a Friday - these will run on a two week timetable with each class having a session once every two weeks. Please ensure your child has P.E kit in school every day.
