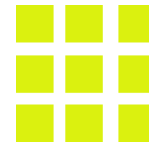

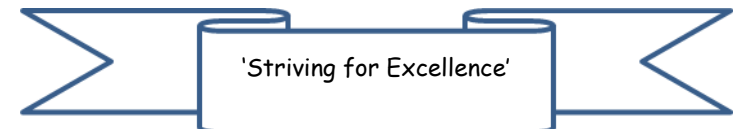

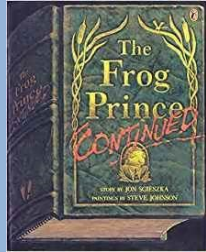




Year 4/5 Autumn Term 1 2019 - Theme: Potions

English

Our text this half term is going to be The Frog Prince...Continued by Jon Scieszka. Through the text children will learn the skills needed to write love letters, diary entries, a play script and finally, their own fairy story.



Science – What a state!

We will learn about states of matter. They will learn about solids, liquids and gases and their uses and importance. We will plan tests to see what happens to food items if we heat or freeze them.

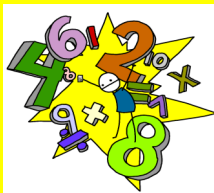


Religious Education

In RE we will be learning about the concept of beliefs and their importance. They will learn about Christian beliefs and what is the value of what Christians believe about Jesus' miracles.

Mathematics

This half term we are securing place value knowledge and then focusing on addition and subtraction using expanded columnar and columnar method. Children will explore the number system to 10,000 using concrete resources, and will also use them to help them add and subtract when having to exchange.



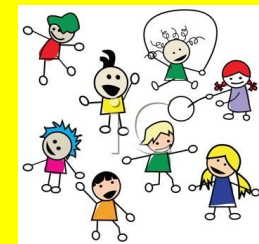
Theme
