EYFS Spring Term 2 2019 - Theme: Superheroes!



Personal Social and Emotional Development

Your child will continue to develop their team work skills through our superhero missions! They will also build up their confidence with other children, learning how to plan an activity.

Communication and Language

Can you hear a superhero? This half term we will be really focusing on maintaining attention and concentrating during carpet time. We will be encouraging the children to listen and respond to ideas expressed by others. I wonder if we will see anyone fly by whilst we are listening on the carpet!

Physical Development

Just like Superheroes, we need to have strong arms, hands and fingers! We will continue to focus on forming our letters correctly in our daily handwriting sessions. We will be exploring the importance of exercise and what it does to our bodies, you've got to be healthy to be a superhero! In PE we will learning about coordination, superheroes need this to help them on their missions.

English

Reading

What would a Superhero read? We will be applying our phase 2 sounds to read simple words and sentences and will continue learning our phase 3 sounds. Remember, practice makes perfect!

Writing

Children will be segmenting the sounds in simple words and writing these. They will also be

attempting to write simple sentences that other can read. I wonder if our writing will be flying high like a caped crusader?

Mathematics

Number

How do numbers get bigger and smaller? We will develop our understanding of number. And begin to use the language involved in addition and subtraction.

Shape, Space and Measure

Through different missions children will develop their understanding of capacity, time and introducing the language of money. Will we be able to save the day with our new skills?

Understanding of the World

People and Communities

As part of our superhero topic we will be celebrating that everyone is different, we have all got our own super powers! Also, we will be learning about 'Real life superheroes', for example, firefighters, doctors and the police.

The World

We will be exploring different concepts such as magnets, floating and sinking, melting and freezing through challenges set by the superheroes.

Technology

We will explore a range of technology including programmable toys, computers and iPads .

Exploring and Using Media and Materials

We will be exploring using a variety of materials and tools to construct with while designing and making superhero vehicles and dens. Who will come out on top by having the best transport and home?

Being Imaginative

Will we save the day or end up being captured? We will represent our own ideas through role play and stories through our theme of superheroes. We will be busy acting out different scenarios as well developing our own missions.
