Parking

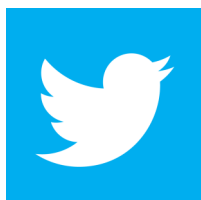
We have been approached by a number of neighbours recently complaining about parking on the surrounding roads. Please park with respect and courtesy to all local residents.



We also request that you leave the road outside school free of parked cars.

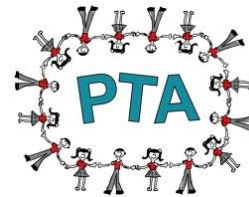
Facebook and Twitter

We have received a number of E-Safety concerns around the use of the popular gaming site Roblox.

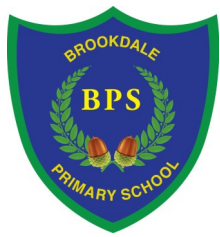
