## Statutory Assessment



The dates for KS1 and KS2 Statutory Assessments are on 'What's On'.

If for any reason your child is absent, please let us know as soon as possible as we need to inform the Standards and Testing Agency and make arrangements for the tests to be administered on an alternative day.



## Empty Classroom Day

Dates are on 'What's On'

Children are not required to wear school uniform. On Empty Classroom day they should be suitably dressed to do their learning outside all day (warm clothes, suitable footwear)

## House PE Day

For House PE Day they will need to be dressed in school PE Kit, to take part in activities both inside and outside. They will also need a water bottle.
