COVID Update

Given the rise in COVID 19 cases we have been advised by the Local Authority to keep all existing protective measures in place. This means that **face coverings should continue to be worn on the playground** and **social distancing should be observed**. Protective measures within school will also remain in place including the wearing of masks by adults in communal areas and hygiene and cleaning regimes.

Our Local Authority has also asked schools to continue contact tracing until new rules come into force on 16th August, regarding Under 18's and those that have received two doses of the vaccine. This means that if we have a positive case in school we would contact our Local Authority, who would advise us on what action we need take. This means that a whole bubble may not necessarily need to close.

I am sure you will want to help us reduce the risk of the spread of infection, as none of us would wish to be required to isolate at the start of the summer holidays, potentially affecting any holidays we may have planned.

As yet, we have not been given any guidance for September, but I will keep you updated as soon as possible.
