



Dear Parents/Carers,

We are very excited to introduce Dale Hall's Matchbox Challenge!

This is a fun Easter activity that we hope the children will enjoy whilst also raising money for the school. Your child will be taking home a Challenge Pack containing a matchbox, a sponsorship form, a Matchbox Item List and instructions.

Here's how it works...

The challenge is to collect and fit as many DIFFERENT items into your matchbox as you can. Only **one of each item is permitted**, so unfortunately filling the box with grains of sand is not allowed!

- You will receive a Matchbox and a matchbox item list to help keep track of how many items you have in your matchbox.
- You may then collect sponsorship from friends and family (for example 10p per item).
- Bring your filled and decorated matchboxes back to school after the Easter holidays on 17<sup>th</sup> of April. **On the bottom please write your child's name and Class.**
- Sponsorship money in a labelled envelope collected by Friday 20<sup>th</sup> April
- No duplicates (if you put a seed of every fruit and flower it still counts as just one...a seed!)  
No body parts (toenail clippings, hair etc) No living (or dead things) including ants, spiders or beetles.
- Judges decision is final on whether items can / cannot be accepted.

There will be prizes awarded for the most number of items in the box, the most amount of money raised and for the best decorated matchbox!

The money we raise will be used to purchase Chrome Books and ipads for use across the school. Not only is this lots of fun it will also benefit your child's education provision.
