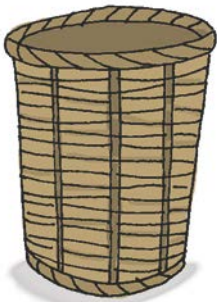
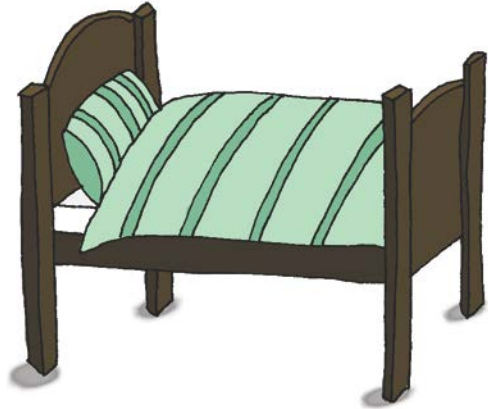




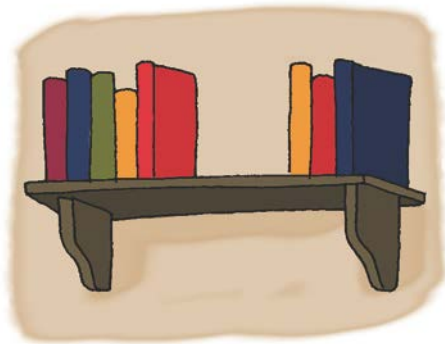
Mr Hop is sad. He has lost the Easter Eggs.

Where can they be?



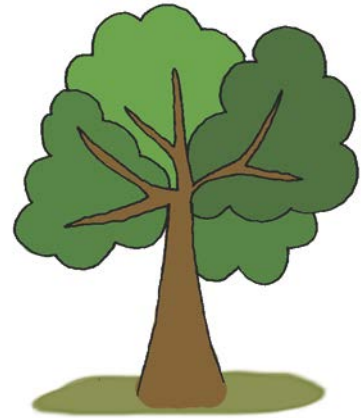
Mrs Hop is happy. She has played a trick on him. She has hidden the eggs. She gives him clues.

<p>Do the clues start inside or outside?</p> <p>Outside – it says go into the garden</p> <p>Predictions and Inferences</p>	<p>Where does Mr Hop find the first clue?</p> <p>In a bag</p> <p>Comprehension</p>	<p>Where does Mr Hop find the second clue?</p> <p>Behind a big pot</p> <p>Comprehension</p>
<p>Where does he find the eggs?</p> <p>Up a tree</p> <p>Comprehension</p>	<p>What happens at the end of the story?</p> <p>He finds the eggs and takes them to the children.</p> <p>Comprehension</p>	<p>Was Mr Hop still sad at the end of the story?</p> <p>No because he had found the eggs again.</p> <p>Predictions and Inferences</p>

<p>What type of text is this?</p> <p>A story</p> <p>Themes and Conventions</p>	<p>What is this story about?</p> <p>Mr Hop has lost his eggs because Mrs Hop has hidden them from him. She gives him clues to help him find them.</p> <p>Comprehension</p>	<p>What is this type of game called, when you hide something and leave clues for someone to find them?</p> <p>A treasure hunt</p> <p>Predictions and Inferences</p>
<p>Can you find a word with the th grapheme? What sound does th make?</p> <p>the, they, there, /th/</p> <p>Comprehension</p>	<p>Did the story have a happy ending?</p> <p>Yes, because he found the eggs.</p> <p>Comprehension</p>	<p>What does 'under' mean?</p> <p>Beneath or covered by something</p> <p>Comprehension</p>
<p>What is a shelf?</p> <p>A board on the wall or a piece of furniture that you put things on– again the children may point to one if there is one in the room</p> <p>Comprehension</p>	<p>What is a 'clue'?</p> <p>Something that helps to solve a mystery</p> <p>Comprehension</p>	<p>Was the second clue behind a small pot?</p> <p>No, because it says the big pot.</p> <p>Comprehension</p>
