Children must be at the stage door at 6.30pm stage door, please see the app for more details and consent form.

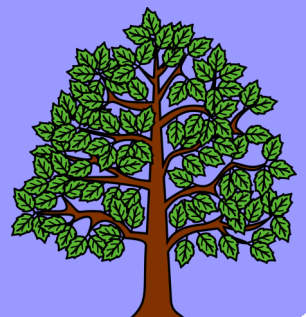

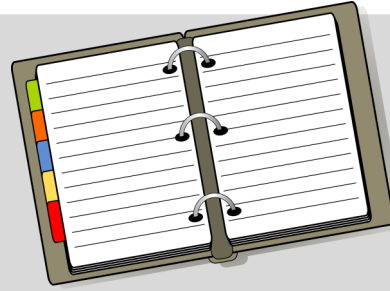

Holidays in Term Time

Holidays in term time will only be granted in exceptional circumstances, this is in accordance with our School Absence Policy (a copy can be found on our school website).

The percentage of attendance for all children should be above 96%.

Attendance/Punctuality

If your child is going to be absent from school, please contact the school office before 8:45am to advise school of the reason for your child's absence. Failure to notify school of your child's absence will result in your child having an unauthorised absence recorded on the school register.

If your child's absent from school is due to illness and your child is in the RED or AMBER attendance group, school MUST receive medical evidence to authorise the absence. Failure to provide school with the necessary medical evidence may result in your child being referred to our Educational Welfare Officer.

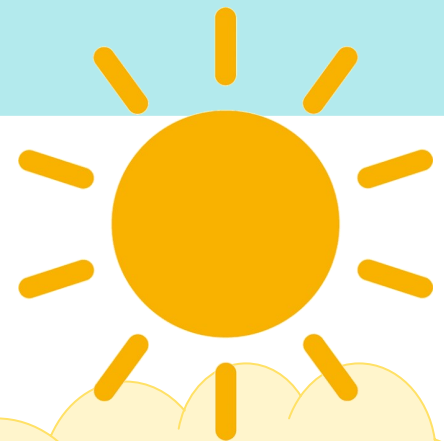
If your child is ill for more than 48 hours please contact school with an update.

Holidays should not to be taken in term time however, if you are going on holiday in term time you need to collect a Leave of Absence Form from the School Office (we ask for 6 weeks notice).

Unauthorised absence's may result in a fine from The Educational Welfare Department.

Children need to arrive at school between 8:45am and 8:55am. Registers are taken at 9am and children not present at this time will be recorded as late.

EWO and school have been working closely together and are coming up with new ideas to ensure our school's overall attendance is high and each child arrives to school on time.
