Kynance Class

Kynance have had a busy week being teachers. They have been testing adults on their speed sounds using our new class pinnies. In maths this week, we have been working on consolidating numbers to 10. Many of the children can count to 10 confidently, but are a little unsure one more and one less. We use a number line daily to jump on and back. Can your child tell you a specific numeral out of sequence? E.g. a door number? Or a button on the remote?

As the weather was very wet on Wednesday, we hid and found our rocks in our garden. The children enjoyed this and we will continue to hide and find them.

Next week we are going to make sounds using empty bottles. Please could you send in any old plastic bottles for us to use in the water tray.

Gwithian Class

Next week we are going to carry out some exciting science investigations during Science week.

Sennen Class

Next week in Sennen Class, we are going to be starting to innovate our class story with a focus on using different types of sentences. In Maths, we are having a week on division and remainders and thinking about telling the time using a digital clock. In Science, we are going to be thinking about rigid materials and which are good for building bridges. In Topic, we are going to be continuing to think about Da Vinci's flying designs and the commands needed to make the designs.

Fistral Class

Next week, we are focusing on multiplication skills in sums and word problems. In Literacy, we are looking at poetry in the hopes of creating our own. As it is science week, we will be exploring and investigating science experiments to do with plants.

Pentire Class

Next week in Pentire we will be continuing to develop our skills in fractions by adding and subtracting fractions and mixed numbers. In Literacy we will be continuing to innovate our class story and we will be having a grammar focus on adverbs and adjectives.

In Topic work the class will be continuing to make their own paper mache mummified cats! Being Science week we will be completing science investigations daily on our terms topic of forces.

Marazion Class

In English next week, Marazion will be writing an innovated play script focusing on the use of Shakespearean language and the use of stage directions to inform the character of how to act and speak.

In maths next week, we will be finding missing percentages, finding percentage increases and decreases as well as solving fraction, decimal and percentage (fdp) equivalence problems.

Next week during science, we will describe the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood by investigating how the different parts of the circulatory system work.
