There will be all manner of goodies on sale, made by the children, to help raise money for Rainforest Trust UK. The project we have chosen to support is the preservation of the Indonesian Rainforests, where 25 orangutans are killed every day through illegal activities, including logging and clearing for illegal palm oil plantations. Every £2 we raise will help preserve 5 acres of rainforest - our aim is to raise £50. We will also be holding a raffle to win a toy orangutan, similar to the character seen in the Iceland/Greenpeace advertising film.
