We are extremely proud to announce that we have been awarded the Carnegie Centre of Excellence for Mental Health in Schools School Mental Health Award at Silver standard. This is the culmination of over a year's work to embed and further improve our provision to support the mental health and wellbeing of our pupils, families and staff.

Highlights of the final assessment report include:

- Laureate has a family atmosphere, being warm and welcoming, and all members of the school community are conscious of the importance of continuing to nurture this;
- Pupils are increasingly able to say that they feel well cared for, and that their mental health and wellbeing are supported;
