Busy Summer Term Ahead!

We have been delighted to welcome pupils back this week for another busy term, and have already started with some fantastic celebrations:

- Over half the school were part of the termly 'Laureate Challenge' celebrations today (Friday), with every pupil who achieved a full set of 'Excellent' effort and behaviour grades in the spring term enjoying an obstacle course session on the field;
- Over 70 pupils were presented with a certificate recognising their 100% attendance last term, with one lucky boy and girl being drawn at random to receive a £10 book voucher each;
- We presented personalised Laureate water bottles to the first group of pupils who have already run, jogged or walked 100 miles on our Laureate Mile track this year.
