It will be part of a flower festival in the chapel – St Philip and St Etheldreda, which is the little church opposite the Leisure Centre on Exning Road, and was the workhouse chapel. The displays are being put together by the Newmarket Historical Society and will include the history of the tin chapel in St Phillips Road.

This is a call to those who have lived in Newmarket for a fair length of time to ask for loans of photos and memorabilia of the workhouse and its chapel, the maternity hospital (including when the chapel was turned into a squash court) and the tin chapel.
