We have been contacted by a number of local businesses around the school to raise concerns about parking, including:

- Parents parking in, and across the entrances to, private car parks;
- Parents parking on both sides of the narrow roads, limiting access;
- Parents parking in yellow boxes and on yellow lines;
- Parents parking right up to the junctions to Exning Road.

These issues raise serious safety concerns – we do not want another pupil hit by a car. We also take our relationships with the local community very seriously and appreciate the fact that they seldom complain about the congestion caused by the school run. Please respect our neighbours and, if you have to drive your child to school, park responsibly.
