### **Annex C to Behaviour Policy Parent Protocol - Covid-19**

These changes to the behaviour policy will take effect for the period of school opening during the Covid-19 pandemic.

In addition to the usual home-school agreement, parents will be expected to

- Encourage good infection control practices, such as thorough handwashing, at home and remind my child about social distancing rules but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child may not always do this successfully
- Ensure all members of the family adhere to social distancing outside the home to avoid risk of infection to the children, their families and the wider community
- Support home learning wherever possible
- Only come to the school site if invited or by prior arrangement
- Check the school website or facebook page for updates and communicate via email or phone
- If a visit to the school office is unavoidable, maintain social distancing, use hand gel provided and speak through the hatch. There will be a 'one in, one out' policy
- Adhere to any altered routines for arrival and departure (these will be communicated to parents prior to school reopening)
- Adhere strictly to timings for drop-off and pick-up
- Maintain social distance of 2m from anyone not in their household including other parents, children and staff
- Provide children with clean clothes to wear to school every day
- Provide children with a personal water bottle and snack each day, to be brought in to school in a named bag

- Ensure that children do not bring toys or belongings from home to school
- Inform the school if their child or any family member becomes ill
- Request a test if any member of the family is showing symptoms of coronavirus
- If phoned because child is unwell, come immediately to pick them up
- Be supportive of the changes to normal routine and measures put in place to ensure everyone is as safe as possible
- Be respectful to staff and follow their instructions
