Dear Parents,

As an introduction to our work on The Romans, Beech Class will be visiting Caerleon Museum and amphitheatre on Monday 25th September.

Timings: We will leave school at 8:45 to reach Caerleon by 10am, so please bring your child to school for 8:30am, via the library door. We will be leaving the museum at 2:30pm so should return to school by 3:30pm.

Cost: Workshop activities are £2:50 per child, plus coach costs (£ 225), making a total of £10 each. Please indicate payment below. Please pay using School Money. You will receive a text with your login details.

Programme for the day: Arrive 10am. Quick snack and toilets. We will then visit the Roman Baths and the amphitheatre. We will lunch at the museum then attend workshop activities before returning to the coach.

Clothing: Uniform needs to be worn, with a warm, waterproof coat and sensible shoes/ trainers. It may be cold, so black trousers may be more suitable than a skirt. Children will be issued with a high-vis jacket for safety.

Food/ Drink: Your child will need a packed lunch plus 2 drinks (no glass bottles please.) Please let us know in advance if your child needs a free packed lunch. Pupils can bring a snack, although we will also take fruit for Yr2. Please pack snacks separately, so that we do not have to open lunch boxes!

Medical: Please make sure that the school has up to date information on any medical needs/ allergies your child has. Please ensure any necessary equipment (eg inhalers etc) are brought to school on the morning of the trip. Please tick below if your child suffers from travel sickness and would benefit from sitting near the front of the coach.

Museum Shop: If you are happy for your child to buy something from the museum shop, please give them a maximum of £3:00 in a named purse or sealed envelope.

We are looking forward to the day as it should be a really interesting trip. Please just ask if you have any questions or concerns.
