Lighter Meal Options:

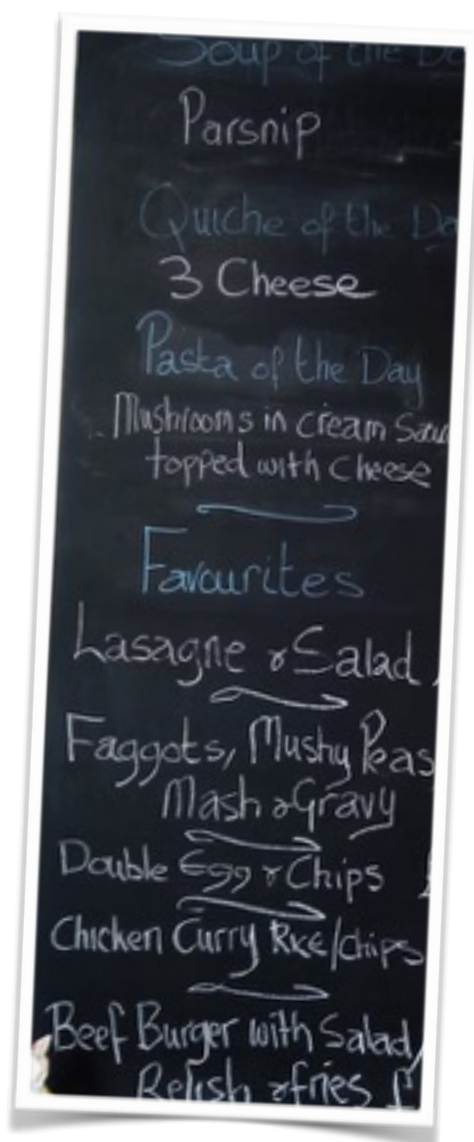
Omelette (cheese or ham or mushroom) with salad
