As it is getting colder, please can you ensure that the children bring a coat and a jumper into school, with their name in it.

PARKING – If you bring your child to school by car, can you please be considerate to our neighbours when you park your car. Also please do not use the Disabled/Taxi bay.

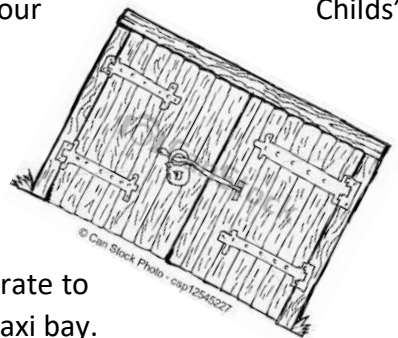
We have had several complaints about drivers (dropping off at school), using neighbours' driveways and paths, to turn cars around. There is sufficient space to turn your vehicle at the top, by **Shepherds Drive**. Please do not park on the junction of **Orchard Close** by the bollards as this is extremely dangerous to other drivers.

SUPERVISION OF CHILDREN - When you bring/collect your child from school, it is the parent/carers responsibility to supervise your child/ren in the playground. They are not allowed on the bank by the hall or to play on the ramp by Skylarks class. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

PACKED LUNCHES – Please do not PUT IN THE LUCH BOXES any foods that contain NUTS, eg: peanut butter sandwiches, chocolate bars with nuts in. We have children at the school who have severe allergies.

SICKNESS BUG – If your child is sick at home, please notify the school that morning, your child will not be able to return to school for 48 hours after the last bout of sickness.

ROAD CLOSURE – We have been advised that **Bratton Road, will be closed from the 18th Oct to 28th**, for traffic calming work to be carried out.
