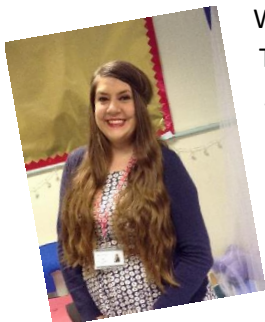
Message from Mrs Huxham
