The Easter Egg Hunt is still going ahead despite the weather, I hope you all enjoy yourself.

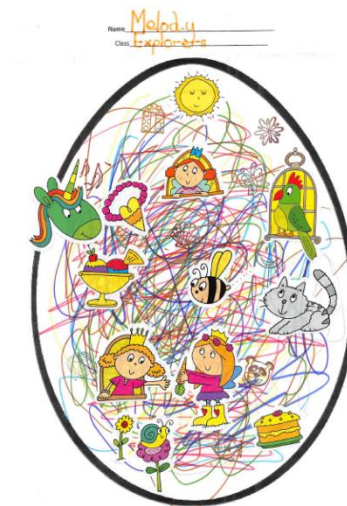
