

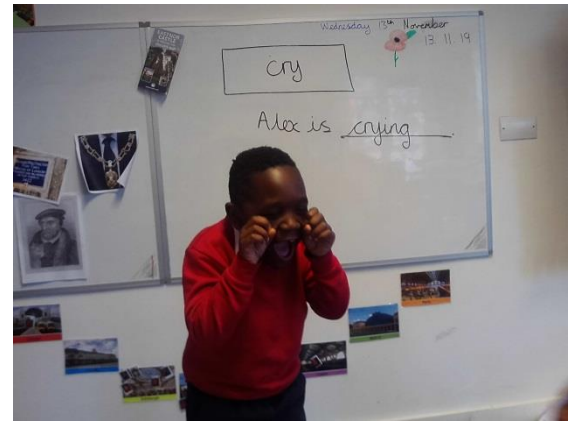
Year 1 – Green, Purple and Orange

What a busy few weeks we have had! In Year 1 we have been preparing for our Christmas play. We have started learning the songs and our lines and can't wait to share with everyone Christmas Rhyme. We have started to create decorations using clay and pipe cleaners, starting our run in to Christmas.



In maths we have been looking at place value within 20. This has included looking at tens and ones, ordering numbers and comparing numbers using vocabulary such as greater than, less than, smallest and largest. We have started looking at addition and subtraction and will be carrying on this topic after Christmas, focusing on counting on using a number line and finding number bonds to 20.

In English we have learning all about rhyming words. We started by reading popular nursery rhymes like Humpty Dumpty, Little Miss Muppet and Doctor Foster. Next, the children identified the rhyming words throughout the poem and finally added actions to remember the poems! We have also looked at verbs and thinking of ones that we already know, such as jumping, walking and running.



In the next few weeks we will be getting more into the festive spirit, looking at Christmas related books and preparing more and more for our Christmas play.
