

## English

In English we will be learning about the features of narrative tales and writing our own. We will revisit the features of non-chronological reports and write our own versions. We will read a selection of challenging fiction and non-fiction texts, and answer associated comprehension questions.

## Science

We will learn about sound: how it is made through vibrations, how it can travel through a medium and look at how the pitch of a sound is linked to the object creating the sound and the length of the vibrations.

## Geography

We will identify key aspects of human geography including: settlements and land use and why people might travel between different countries. We will study aspects of physical geography, including: climate zones & biomes and vegetation belts.

## MFL

We will be learning simple words and phrases in Spanish.

## Computing

We will edit & write HTML.

## Maths

In Maths we will complete our learning about decimal numbers. We will use pounds and pence to solve problems involving money. We will record time in hours, minutes & seconds. We will convert time from analogue to digital on 12 & 24 hour clocks. We will interpret data in charts and graphs.

## RE
