



New Appointment

This term is always an incredibly busy term, where there is still a lot of progress that can be made in terms of learning but, also in terms of preparation for September 2019. We have reports being written as we speak and they are due to be sent out to parents on Wednesday 10th July. We have Transition classes where we move all our children into their new class and meet their new teacher during week beginning 15th July. Year 6 have their Transition 'taster' days scheduled for Tuesday 9th and Wednesday 10th July at Redruth School. Transition arrangements for our new Reception children are well underway and include 'experience days' and meetings with parents as well as home visits. We have our Summer Fayre scheduled for Friday 12th July and Sports Days scheduled for week beginning 8th July. Check the website for dates.

As you will already know, I will be retiring at the end of this year and Crofty Multi Academy Trust and the Governors are busy preparing to interview for the post of a substantive Head teacher. Interviews will take place next Thursday and Friday and once a decision has been made, Governors will inform you as soon as possible.

It is unlikely that the new head teacher will be available to take up post in September and therefore Crofty MAT and Pennoweth Governors have been working hard to find a Head teacher who will be able to lead the school in the interim. We have been fortunate to have secured the services of Linda May, who is currently Head teacher at Treloweth School, to take over the reins until the new head teacher is available and I believe that this will be a perfect fit for our school.

Mrs May is a very experienced and capable Head teacher who has not only been a very successful teacher, but has vast experience in leading schools, having been involved in Nine Maidens School, Pencoys School and now at Treloweth School. She has vast experience of system leadership and is heavily involved in School Improvement work across Crofty MAT.

Mrs May will take the role of Executive Headteacher and oversee both schools for a while. Mrs May will have the support of an experienced leadership team here at Pennoweth and we are looking forward to having her steady influence to keep Pennoweth School moving forward on its ever improving journey.

Unauthorised Exceptional Leave of Absence Information

The law requires parents to ensure their children receive an efficient full time education, and every minute of every day is important. Please help them not to miss any of this valuable time.

We hope that when you have read the information outlined on our website, you will consider that your child's education is too important to take holidays during term time.

If an unauthorised leave of absence is taken, this may incur a penalty notice being issued under Section 444A and 444B of the Education Act 1996. This carries a fine of £60 if paid within 21 days or £120 if paid after this but within 28 days. Failure to pay the penalty notice will result in Court action

Unauthorised Late Marks Information

If your child is arriving late - after the register has closed at 9am, it will be coded as a U which, is an unauthorised late mark. If your child accrues 10 unauthorised late marks within 100 sessions (10 weeks) you will be committing an offence under the Education Act 1996.

The School may refer the matter to Cornwall Council who may decide to take legal action against you., issuing a penalty notice under Section 444A and 444B of the Education Act 1996. This carries a fine of £60 per child, per parent if paid within 21 days or £120 if paid after this but within 28 days. Failure to pay the penalty notice will result in Court action.

Persistent absences/unauthorised lates, not authorised by the school, may result in a prosecution in the Magistrates Court, leading to fines up to £2,500 and / or custodial sentences.
