Dear Parent/Carer

I am delighted that your child is attending our school. With your encouragement, help and support, we will ensure that we all do our very best to see that they are part of many exciting and rewarding experiences.

It is very important that your child learns about making the right choices, not just in school but also in everyday life. The school has developed a new behaviour improvement policy that will help all children to make the right choices about their behaviour enabling them to work, learn and play together in a positive way. Your child deserves to have happy and fulfilling experiences in school and I know that working together will help that to happen. Unauthorised Exceptional Leave of Absence Information

The law requires parents to ensure their children receive an efficient full time education, and every minute of every day is important. Please help them not to miss any of this valuable time.

We hope that when you have read the information outlined on our website, you will consider that your child's education is too important to take holidays during term time.

If an unauthorised leave of absence is taken, this may incur a penalty notice being issued under Section 444A and 444B of the Education Act 1996. This carries a fine of £60 if paid within 21 days or £120 if paid after this but within 28 days. Failure to pay the penalty notice will result in Court action

Unauthorised Late Marks Information

If your child is arriving late - after the register has closed at 9am, it will be coded as a U which, is an unauthorised late mark. If your child accrues 10 unauthorised late marks within 100 sessions (10 weeks) you will be committing an offence under the Education Act 1996.

The School may refer the matter to Cornwall Council who may decide to take legal action against you., issuing a penalty notice under Section 444A and 444B of the Education Act 1996. This carries a fine of £60 per child, per parent if paid within 21 days or £120 if paid after this but within 28 days. Failure to pay the penalty notice will result in Court action.

Persistent absences/unauthorised lates, not authorised by the school, may result in a prosecution in the Magistrates Court, leading to fines up to £2,500 and / or custodial sentences.

Pupil Contact/Medical/Dietary Information

It is of the utmost importance that we always have up-to-date contact/medical/dietary information for all children.

If you are unsure of the current details we hold for your child, please come to the school office to check and, if necessary, make any amendments.



Safety on our School Site

Please be aware that if you drive on to our school site, it is of the utmost importance when you are arriving and leaving, that you keep to a safe speed. There is a high chance that children and families may be within the vicinity.

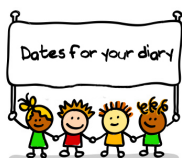
