We have been notified by Thames Valley Police that an explicit video involving a child has been distributed via social media and have been asked by County to pass on this information.

'This [incident] is currently under investigation by Hampshire Constabulary. If you have received this explicit video on Snapchat, Instagram or by any other means you must delete it immediately. If you show this video to someone else or forward it on to other people you could be committing a criminal offence, which the police may investigate and consider prosecution.'

Teaching our children how to be safe online is really important and we will be holding workshops in the New Year to support parents with knowing how to keep their child safe on the internet.
