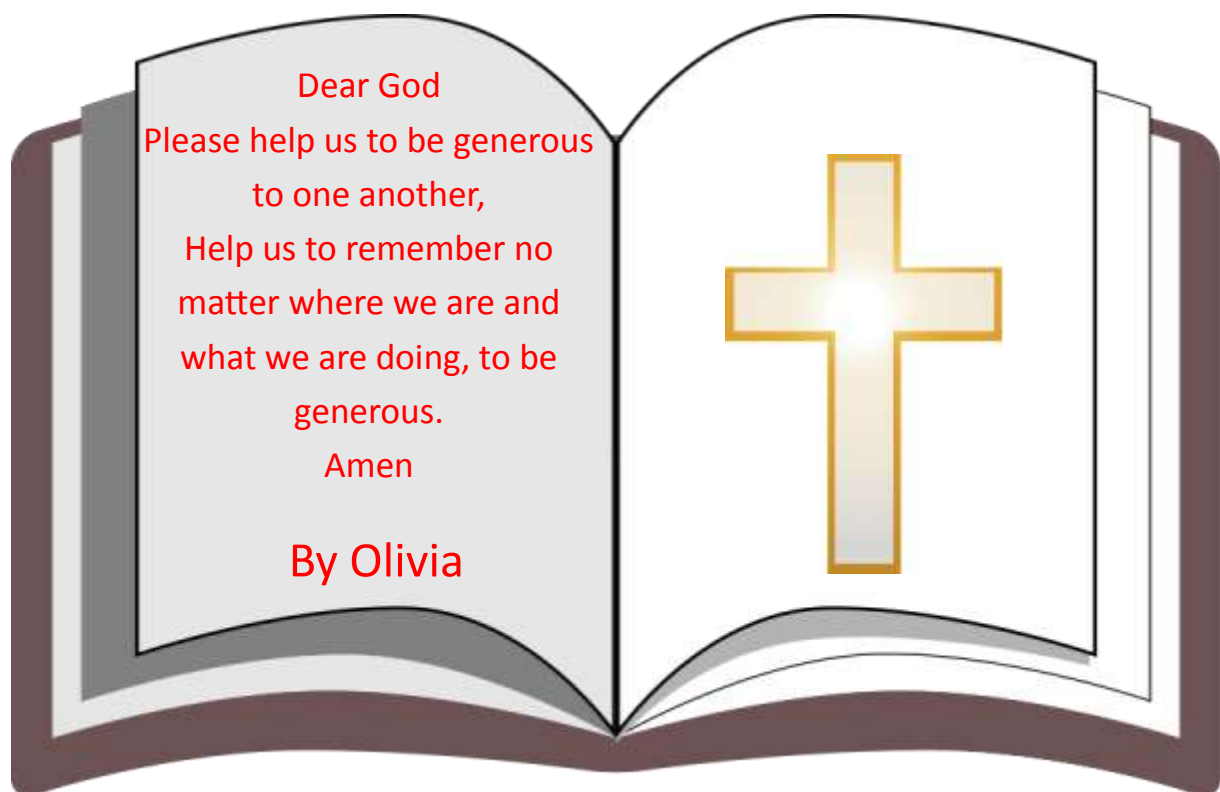

Thank you to those parents who supported the school by booking their child in for a school meal on 4th October. It is so crucial when all schools are finding it difficult because of budget constraints that we make every effort to supplement the school's income as much as we can, thank you all.

Polite notice to ALL parents

Our phonics and spellings sessions are now up and running every morning from 8.50am-9.15am in EVERY class. It is therefore imperative that your child arrives to school on time. Persistent lateness will result in daily sessions being missed which will have a serious impact on your child's reading and writing progress.

Previously, we have operated an open door policy for before and after school, we are now asking that non urgent conversations or messages with teachers take place AFTER school. Again, this will save valuable minutes and increase the length of spelling and phonics sessions. Any urgent messages can be given to Mrs Searle or Mrs Briganti in the school office and they will decide if teachers need to be taken out of class.

Please note reading diaries and notes in bags are a good method of communication to a teacher. In Class one there is a diary by the door that parents are welcome to leave notes in too if they are not confidential.

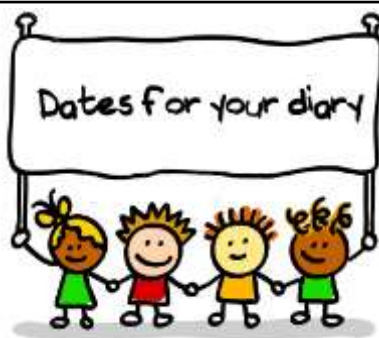
