

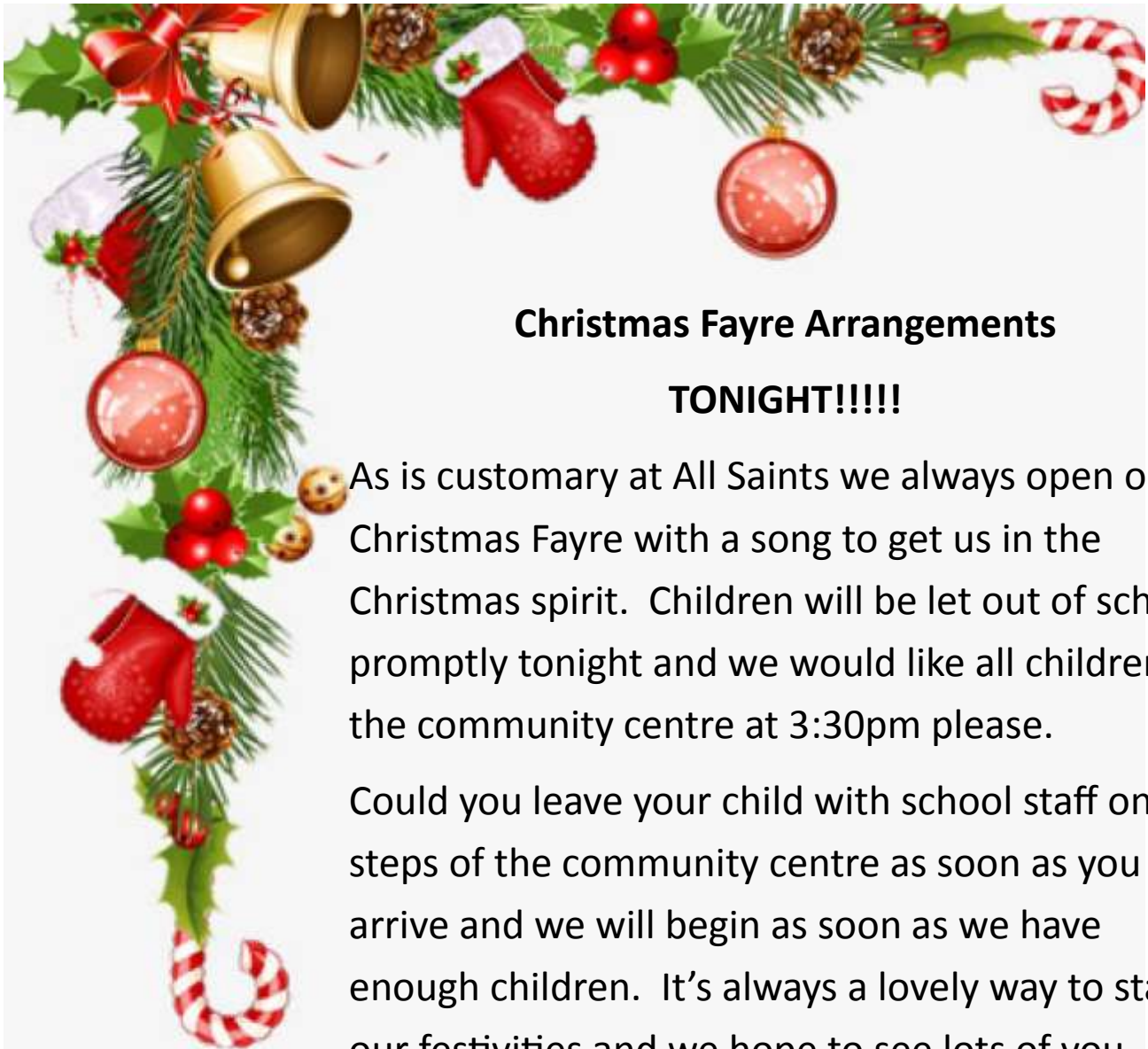

Messy Christingle is on Christmas Eve afternoon 24th December at 3pm at St James Church, Acton Trussell

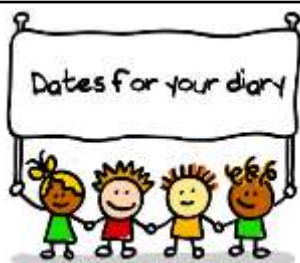
Come along, make Christingle Oranges and sing Christmas carols.
